I.INTRODUCTION

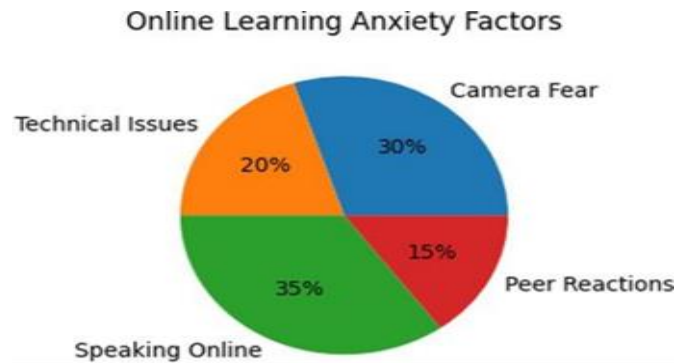

Image: Anxiety During Online Learning



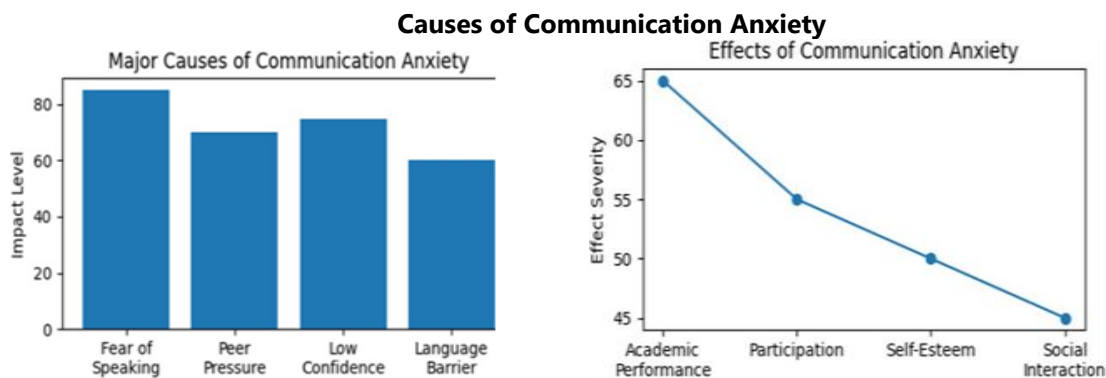
Methods to Reduce Communication Anxiety
